

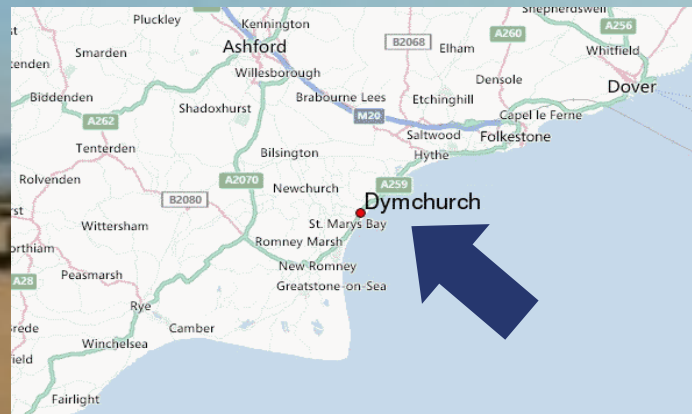

## The Romney, Hythe and Dymchurch Railway

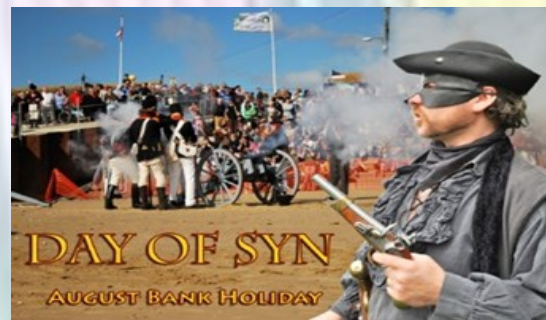


## Martello Tower
