Folly Wildlife Rescue

Rescues all wildlife and has volunteers who cover the whole of Kent. May not be able to collect injured or abandoned wildlife during busy times of the year. Helpline provides useful advice 07957 949825

Willow Wildlife Rescue

Do not rescue birds but will rescue most other wildlife across Kent and Sussex. Has emergency ambulance.

Prickles Hedgehog Haven

Rescues hedgehogs but mainly in north Kent 0208 462 1168

Medway Rescue

Rescues birds only and they do not collect. Injured birds need to be transported to Allhallows 01634 270182 (Jane)

Dr Sandra Betts (Thanet Wildlife Rescue)

Will rescue injured/orphaned baby hedgehogs, fledgling birds and injured gulls and other birds. May be able to collect. Covers Thanet, Herne Bay, Whitstable 01843 844532

Wildlife Lodge Rescue Centre, Beckenham

Charge £5.00 for collecting animals. Often unable to collect but animal can be taken to drop-off point. Areas covered: Bexley, Bromley, Dartford, Swanley, Biggin Hill 07983 708497
